# Here are the Wearable Tech Heroes 2016 7th WT Innovation World Cup Finalists announced

The winners will be announced at the official award ceremony on January 26th at the 19th WT | Wearable Technologies Conference in Munich – THE gathering of the wearable ecosystem.
